#### **ITINERARY**

## **Cusco Day 1**

SAT JAN 1

You will be met at the airport and transferred to your comfortable hotel near the main square of Cusco. Rest a few hours to acclimate to the altitude. 1:00 pm: Meet your guide in the hotel lobby. Willka T'ika invites you to a delicious Peruvian meal in the Plaza de Armas, the main square vibrant with local people, tourists and fascinating colonial and Incan architecture. Your professional guide will introduce you to Incan history as he leads you through the picturesque cobblestone streets of San Blas, pointing out fascinating stonework en route to the Koricancha Temple, the holiest site during Incan times. In the evening, rest or dine in one of the highly-acclaimed restaurants of your choice near the main square. The guide will offer suggestions.

#### Cusco & Sacred Valley Day 2

SUN JAN 2

AM: After breakfast at the hotel, your guide will take you to the giant stones of Saksaywaman overlooking the city of Cusco where hike around the vast Incan site. Continue on a guided tour to the Incan ritual fountains at Tampumachay. Participate in a ceremony to honor Yaku, the spirit of water, to open the body's energy centers. A traditional coca-leaf ceremony invites you to tap into the energies of Pachamama, Mother Earth. Your guide will offer suggestions on where to lunch before departure for the Sacred Valley. En route, stop at the amazing Moray agricultural circles before descending through spectacular mountain scenery. If interested in wonderful traditional weaving, you may also stop in **Chinchero** to visit a center. PM: Arrive at Willka T'ika before dinner. Welcome and introduction to the Quechua WillkaT'ika family, who will take care of your needs during your stay. At that time, appointments may be made for spa treatments (B.L.D)

#### Fire Ceremony Day 3

MON JAN 1


AM: This day is dedicated to Pachamama, Mother Earth. A guided tour of the renowned Seven Chakra Gardens is offered. Take an optional guided walk through the nearby Rumichaka farming neighborhood where Quechua campesinos live. For active guests, enjoy more challenging hikes along scenic routes into the valley. Families can choose to go horse back riding, zip lining, rafting or biking locally—additional costs apply. PM: Lunch at 1 p.m. After, indulge in an Andean spa treatment, yoga or read and relax in the gardens. Later in the afternoon, an optional 15-minute coca-leaf reading is offered by your pakko (Qero healer) visiting from the high Andes. Your guide will translate. After dinner, the pakko invites you to an authentic Andean offering to Pachamama, and a transformative fire ceremony beneath the stars, to honor Her, yourself and loved ones. The ceremony focuses intention for your journey and serves as a wonderful preparation of mind, body and spirit for your pilgrimage to Machu Picchu. (B.L.D)

# School Visit & P'isaq Day 4

TUES JAN 1

AM: Ayni is Andean reciprocity. Drive through the Sacred Valley to a Quechua mountain school supported by the nonprofit Willka T'ika Children's Fund. Since 1995, Willka T'ika has supported high mountain community communities where few tourists are privileged to visit. In an ayni exchange, you are invited to offer an activity the children can enjoy. The warmth and heart-warming joy of the children, and their openness in bringing guests into their daily lives are special moments not easily forgotten. Afterward, enjoy a riverside bag lunch.

PM: Continue to the famous P'isaq site where you may hike along the magnificent view of the ancient terraces, and later stop by the colorful P'isaq market filled with woven goods, jewelry, wall hangings and hand-painted beadwork. P'isaq is a photographer's dream. (B.L.D)





## Machu Picchu Day 5

WFD JAN 1

AM: Early breakfast. Board the tourist train to Aguas Calientes, gateway to the majestic terraces of Machu Picchu. Your guide will offer a wonderful guided tour of the citadel and a moderate hike to the Incan Sun Gate, and then accompany you by bus back to your riverside lodge. PM: Your guide will meet you outside the lodge at 6 p.m. Willka T'ika invites you to a fabulous three-course dinner in one of the finest restaurants in Aguas Calientes. (B.D)

# Machu Picchu Day 6

**THURS JAN 1** 

AM: For the second day at Machu Picchu, choose either to return to the citadel, or hike to a small museum and continue alongside the railway track to a tropical waterfall where one experiences a different climate called ceja de selva, brow of the jungle vegetation. You may opt to climb Huayna Picchu Peak or Machu Picchu Peak depending on ticket availability, or return to Aguas Calientes town for lunch or market shopping. PM: Train departs in the afternoon for Ollantaytampu. Transfer to Willka T'ika in time for a late dinner at 7 p.m. (B.D)

# **Urubamba & Maras Day 7**

FRI JAN 1

**AM:** Take a guided walk to the nearby town of Urubamba and experience its bustling Friday-morning colorful local market. Walk to a nearby alpaca store with their own factory that makes highquality sweaters and clothing, and then visit the famous Seminario Pottery studio. Eat lunch on your own at recommended restaurants, and return by motor taxi back to Willka T'ika for \$1 for 2.

PM: Take a round trip hike on zig-zag paths up to the ancient Maras salt farms; or if you prefer, we can request a van at an additional cost to drop you off at the top of the salt farms and you can return by walking down the steep valley paths. For highly adventurous guests, you may also book zip-lining and/or a rockclimbing outing that includes lunch for that day. (B.L.D)



#### **Departure Day 8**

SAT JAN 1

**10:00 a.m.** Check-Out Time. Arrange for a personal early morning yoga and meditation session before breakfast. Your private transfer at check-out takes you to the Cusco airport for your flight home. From Willka T'ika, allow 3 ½ hours before your Cusco flight. Ideal flights depart from Cusco between 2 pm-5 p.m. For departure flights after 6 p.m., please contact our Willka T'ika office. Arrive home feeling blessed with the pure spiritual energy of your transformational Andean journey-of-a-lifetime. (B)

#### SIMPLE FOR GUESTS

Willka T'ika staff will help ensure that all your trip arrangements go as smoothly as possible. Times of activities may be flexible to suit your needs. Your professional tour guide is included on all days with scheduled outings.



#### LOGISTICS AND PAYMENT

Willka T'ika was originally conceived and is lovingly maintained as a private garden retreat center. It is open only to registered guests.

**Reservation:** A nonrefundable \$750/person deposit, together with a completed registration waiver, available <u>HERE</u>, confirms your private tour dates. The fully-inclusive cost per person is \$3550, with shared luxury accommodations (either 2 queens or 1 king) at Willka T'ika; a single room is an additional \$750/person. Family discount rate available for guests under 18. The final balance is due 60 days prior to your tour start date.

**Arrival/Departure**: Program services begin with a private transfer from the Cusco airport on Day One and end with a private transfer from Willka T'ika to the Cusco airport on Day Eight. If you wish to arrive a day earlier at the start of the program, you may request Willka T'ika to arrange an extra night in the same comfortable Cusco hotel. Please advise at time of registration.
